February 9, 2026, Board Meeting Minutes

The Chairwoman called the meeting to order at 5:31pm on February 9, 2026, in the 2nd floor conference room of the Sweetwater Co. Health and Human Services Building, 333 Broadway St, Rock Springs, Wyoming.

Agenda: Mr. Legerski moved to approve the agenda; Mr. Moss seconded. Motion carried.

Additions or changes to the Minutes: None.

Minutes: Mr. Brubaker moved to approve the minutes; Mr. Legerski seconded. Motion carried.

Formal and/or Informal Petitions from the Floor: None.

Manager’s Report:

- **Action Items:** 1) Mr. Chetterbock discussed accepting an RFP for a portable litter fence from Metta Technologies, with the RFP attached hereto as **Exhibit A**. Ms. Apel moved to accept the RFP; Mr. Moss seconded. Motion carried. 2) Mr. Chetterbock discussed purchasing a Danuser T-Post driver to assist in installing litter fencing, with the retail purchase order attached hereto as **Exhibit B**. Ms. Apel moved to purchase a Danuser T-Post driver; Mr. Legerski seconded. Motion carried. 3) Mr. Chetterbock discussed approving a \$500.00 five-year longevity bonus for District employee Mike Kelley. Ms. Apel moved to approve the longevity bonus; Mr. Moss seconded. Motion carried. 4) Mr. Chetterbock discussed Trihydro’s monitoring contract for 2026-2027. Ms. Apel moved to accept and execute the Trihydro contract as presented; Mr. Moss seconded. Motion carried.
- **Non-Action Items:** 1) Mr. Chetterbock provided updates on closing on high wind days after consulting with other high wind impacted landfills (e.g., Cheyenne), but will propose a recommendation in the following meeting. Mr. Legerski asked how it would impact waste haulers. Mr. Chetterbock noted that

waste haulers would still be allowed but it would be closed to the public. 2) Mr. Chetterbock discussed the draft contract for tire regionalization. Mr. Chetterbock noted his desire to obtain complete diversion for tires and how that can be incorporated into the contract (e.g., frequency of shredding, total tonnage accepted, etc.). Mr. Brubaker asked whether a memorandum of understanding would be included with other counties as well as what the cost of purchasing a shredder versus the cost of this contract. Mr. Chetterbock stated that the cost is significantly higher than the costs of this contract. Additionally, the District will discuss with other landfills further as the plan evolves but it is being evaluated on a per-tonnage charge from other landfills. Mr. Legerski suggested having other landfills pay to ship tires to the District but sharing resale value to some percentage.

- **Updates:** 1) Mr. Chetterbock provided an update on the HDR master plan, anticipated completion in March, including lift planning, diverting recyclables, and food waste. 2) Mr. Chetterbock noted that he sent e-waste to Xscindo, including total metrics regarding what was diverted. 3) Mr. Chetterbock noted the District's compliance with Title V with the Department of Environmental Quality. 4) Mr. Chetterbock discussed upcoming speaking engagement with the Rock Springs Chamber of Commerce, including speaking on a Mill Levy. Mr. Legerski suggested increases and decreases to the Mill Levy. Mr. Chetterbock also noted speaking to the mines. 5) Mr. Chetterbock discussed the status of Pacific Steel recycling, including being approximately \$23,000.00 above budget. 6) Mr. Chetterbock discussed an amendment submitted to expand the compost area. 7) Mr. Chetterbock updated on his tour of the Teton County transfer station. 8) Mr. Chetterbock noted that the District should know by the end of the month whether it will receive the water truck grant. 9) Mr. Chetterbock discussed completing the State Bank CD purchase. 10) Mr. Chetterbock updated on website usage.

New Business: None.

Old Business: None.

Financial Statement/Payment of Vouchers: Mr. Varley provided a summary of the District's current financial report. Ms. Apel moved to accept financials as presented by Summit Accounting Services, P.C.; Mr. Moss seconded. Motion carried.

Adjournment: Ms. Apel moved to adjourn; Mr. Moss seconded. Motion carried.


